Production Incentives

Production incentives as of 1 January, 2025

- **25%** for fiction cinema/TV/series and documentary
- **35%** for animation and digital production
- cap per project of **450 million** CZK / 18 million EUR

Production incentives as of 1 January, 2026

- **25%** for fiction cinema/TV/series and documentary
- **35%** for animation and digital production
- cap per project of **450 million** CZK / 18 million EUR
- updated project administration
- new minimum spent limits and runtimes
- introduction of an incentive for documentary series

Financing of Support

Selective support to be financed by:

Parafiscal levies

- **2%** of cinema ticket revenues
- **2%** of broadcast advertising revenues
- **2%** of cable/satellite broadcast revenues
- **3.5%** obligatory assessment on revenues from VoD: 1% levy and 2.5% variable combination of levy and direct investment obligation

The amount collected from parafiscal levies will be mirrored by a contribution from the state budget: the same amount as the levies for selective support and six times the amount of the levies for production incentives.



Czech Audiovisual Fund

The CAF is the main public financing body for the audiovisual industry in the Czech Republic. It supports all stages of AV production, plus promotion, distribution, and other AV-related areas. The CAF also administers production incentives for audiovisual content made in the Czech Republic.

Czech Film Center

The CFC promotes and markets Czech audiovisual content and the local film industry worldwide. It collaborates with major international festivals and co-production platforms and utilizes a global network of partners.

Czech Film Commission

The CFCom promotes the country, and its infrastructure, as the world's top destination for audiovisual production.
